 \Box Student engaged in the care of his family members: student not occasionally engaged in the care and assistance of relatives who are not self-sufficient for reasons of age or physical or mental health. For the purposes of this provision, relatives are considered to be: ascendants (up to the 2nd degree), children and siblings up to the age of 13, the student's spouse. □ **Student suffering from illnesses** that physically prevent or discourage systematic attendance of teaching activities and the consequent taking of the ordinary assessment tests foreseen for full-time students for each Academic Year. The student must submit suitable certification issued no more than three years ago by National Health Service facilities or by specialists and bodies accredited by the same.

□ **Pregnant student:** pregnant student from the sixth month of pregnancy or with a diagnosis of high-risk pregnancy, certified by the specialist doctor.

□ **Student with children:** refers to the student with children under the age of 18.

I declare that I have carefully read the *UNISG Regulations for Part-time student enrollment*, in particular:

Article 3 – SUBMISSION OF THE APPLICATION FOR PART-TIME ENROLLMENT

3.1 – Interested students can apply for part-time enrollment by sending the relevant form (SSTU07, downloadable from the Student Portal) to the Registrar's Office during admission to the first year of the course or before renewing enrollment for subsequent years (by September 1st of each year), accompanied by the necessary documentation (article 2).

3.2 – The acquisition of part-time student status starts from the moment of acceptance of the abovementioned application and is valid for the entire academic year. The part-time status cannot be changed during the year. Part-time student status is automatically renewed for subsequent academic years unless a formal request for status change (downloadable from the Student Portal) is sent to the Registrar's Office before the commencement following academic year.

3.3 – Students enrolled on a part-time basis for subsequent academic years are required to sign a self-declaration (SSTU07, which can be downloaded downloadable from the Student Portal) in which they certify that they meet the requirements stipulated in article 2, which is the basis for access to part-time student status.

3.4 – Students whose cohort has completed in-class academic activities and the beneficiaries of tuition waivers cannot apply for the part-time enrollment.
