Provisions for the Activation of Elective Courses for the Two-Year Graduate Degree Program

ELECTIVE COURSES

Beginning with a.y. 2022/2023

Each elective focus has a maximum duration of 40 hours and includes 2 academic activities:

- n. 1 course with frontal lectures;

- n. 1 specific Field Project.

The student must acquire a total of 9 ECTS credits by the end of the Two-Year Graduate Degree program.

The focuses chosen for Year II of the program are necessarily scheduled in the first semester, to allow for the curricular internship to be carried out in the second semester.

Focus program content may undergo changes, should fewer than 8 students enroll.

STUDENTS AND ENROLLMENTS

Students in Year II of the Two-Year Graduate Degree program must enroll in the elective courses by completing their Career Plan on or before September 30. Only 1 focus may be chosen.

In order to better plan the course contents by determining the number of participants in advance, students will be asked to express a preference between two focuses in the month of February in the preceding academic year.

AUDITORS (valid beginning with a.y. 2019/2020)

Students are given the opportunity to attend elective course lessons **NOT**-PRESENT in their Career Plan, provided that:

- such courses are in addition to those already foreseen for the a.y. they are currently attending;
- they receive prior authorization from the lecturer;
- there is no overlap with course lessons present on their Career Plan.

PLEASE NOTE

Regularly-enrolled students are only required to take exams for courses they are enrolled in; this obligation is not foreseen for auditors.
