



Regulations for Choosing and Activating Optional Courses Two-Year Graduate Degree

As of the 2024/2025 cohort

The Two-Year Graduate Degree program includes four optional courses, taught in the first semester of the second year of the course.

Students must choose two of these optional courses from among those offered.

Course Choices

In order to better plan the content based on the number of participants, during the months of March and April of the preceding academic year, students will be asked to choose two courses from those offered. The collection of preferences will be managed by the administration office using the most appropriate means for this purpose.

The university reserves the right to not activate any course where the number of students enrolled is less than five.

Inclusion in the Study Plan

Students in the second year of the Two-Year Graduate Degree course must enroll in the courses by completing a Study Plan no later than September 30 of each year.

Two courses can be chosen from among the four offered.

Should the Career Plan not be updated by the aforementioned date, the Degree Convenor may officially assign the elective courses deemed most appropriate to the student.

AUDITORS (valid from the 2019/2020 cohort)

Students can attend classes in optional courses NOT INCLUDED in their Study Plan, on the condition that:

- the course is in addition to those in which the student has already enrolled for that academic year.
- the coordinating lecturer has authorized their attendance.
- there are no scheduling conflicts with the classes for courses included in their Study Plan.

NB

Students can take exams only for the courses in which they are officially enrolled. Auditors cannot take the exams.
