



## CONFIDENTIALITY AGREEMENT

### BETWEEN

**The University of Gastronomic Sciences of Pollenzo**, with registered office at Piazza Vittorio Emanuele II no. 9 – Pollenzo – 12042 Bra (CN), represented by the Director General, Stefania Ribotta.

**HAVING REGARD TO** the “Regulations for the activation and management of an alias careers”  
(hereinafter the “Regulations”) adopted by the University of Gastronomic Sciences of Pollenzo;

### IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS

1. Based on the principle of gender self-determination, the University accepts the will of the Applicant and, in order to protect the psychological and physical well-being of the person making the request, undertakes to activate the Alias Identity by assigning a provisional and non-transferable identity. For this purpose, two virtual personal identification cards (hereinafter "badges") will be issued.

The services accessible through the two badges are detailed below:

#### REGISTERED NAME BADGE

- Access to the personal online student services portal for:
- Exam registration
- Submission of the study plan online
- Procedures for international mobility



- Internship activation procedures
- Student collaborations (150 hours)
- Scholarships and financial aid
- Email account
- Library access

#### ALIAS IDENTITY BADGE

- Access to the personal online student services portal
- Identification during exams
- Submission of the study plan online
- Email account
- Library access

2. The Alias Identity is inseparably associated with the legally recognized registered identity and remains active for its entire duration, except as provided for in Article 4, paragraph 4 of the Regulation.
3. Everyone involved in the procedure for the activation and management of the Alias Identity, as well as those to whom the Applicant's Alias Identity is disclosed during this process, are bound by confidentiality obligations regarding the processing of the Applicant's sensitive personal data.
4. The designated point of contact for the Alias Identity procedure at the University is the Head of Anti-Discrimination, Disability, and Social Inclusion Policies.
5. The Applicant commits to notifying the designated University contact in advance and in a timely manner of any planned activities within the University that may have external significance. The Applicant also agrees to confirm and coordinate with this contact regarding the appropriate methods and procedures for utilizing their chosen identity.
6. The Applicant agrees to notify the designated University contact without delay regarding any court ruling pertaining to the rectification of sex and name assignment, or in the event of a decision to terminate the process related to such rectification.
7. Personal data processed under this agreement shall be handled by the University of Gastronomic Sciences of Pollenzo, as data controller, in compliance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR) and applicable national legislation. The data processing is exclusively aimed at managing the alias career and protecting the identity of the Applicant. Authorized University staff involved in data processing are required to comply with confidentiality obligations and the security measures provided for by current legislation. This confidentiality agreement is effective from the date of signing and terminates immediately when the conditions that gave rise to it cease to exist.
8. Any disputes arising from this agreement shall fall under the exclusive jurisdiction of the Court of Turin.
