We'll have lunch in Veneto at Ca' de Memi, a farmhouse focusing on rare indigenous poultry breeds, ancient apples, figs and cinquantino maize (Slow Food Presidium)

Tuesday, January 13, 2026

Breakfast in the rooms

At 9:00, we'll head out for a visit of the La Subida estate, followed by a visit to Acetaia Sirk. This will include a short walk through the property and a focus on artisanal vinegar production, made from Ribolla Gialla grapes, a local and traditional product of the area

We'll start with the newly opened Trifolium winery by Kristian Keber, located on Slovenian territory and recognized as an award-winning example of biodynamic viticulture. We'll then continue to the historic Keber cellar, and the visit will end with a wine tasting

Wednesday, January 14, 2026

Breakfast in the rooms and check out with luggages

9:00

Departure by bus and head towards the Carso area, a distinctive plateau in the Friuli region. The Carso is famous for its rocky limestone terrain and a mix of Mediterranean and Central European influences. This unique landscape has shaped local culture, agriculture, and traditional ways of life over the centuries. The morning will be dedicated to discovering the Zidarich winery, an extraordinary example of heroic viticulture. Here the vines grow on steep limestone slopes, and the cellar itself is spectacularly carved deep into the stone. We'll enjoy a light lunch on site, paired with a tasting of the wines

In the afternoon we'll visit Fattoria Antoniĉ, a didactic and production farm focusing on dairy and meat products. The farm is especially dedicated to the Carsolina sheep, an indigenous breed currently at risk of extinction. This breed is recognized as a Slow Food Presidium, which means it is part of a program that protects traditional foods, preserves biodiversity, and supports small-scale producers who maintain sustainable, high-quality local practices. After the farm visit, we'll continue our journey to Trieste for check-in at Hotel Urban

Thursday, January 15, 2026

Breakfast at Hotel Urban

At 8:30, we'll depart by bus for a activity with the WWF Miramare Marine Protected Area. Please note that the activity will only take place in favorable weather conditions. The focus will be on mussel farming, sustainable small-scale fishing, and the biodiversity of the northern Adriatic Sea. The class will be divided into three groups, rotating through three activities, each lasting about an hour. One group will take a boat excursion with a WWF expert to observe the mussel farms and explore the area from the sea (please dress warmly). Another group will participate in a session on local small-scale fishing, including a short presentation and discussion with a mussel producer. The third group will have free time to explore the Miramare Castle park
